

Age of retirement of board level appointees in Central PSEs—raising from 58 to 60 years.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM of even number dated the 30<sup>th</sup> May, 1998 on the subject mentioned above and to say that it has been decided to insert the following sub-para in the O.M. dated 30<sup>th</sup> May, 1998:-

- (f) No extension in service shall be granted to a board level appointee after he/she attains the age of 60 years. A Board level appointee who has attained the age of 60 years on or before

30<sup>th</sup> May, 1998 but was granted extension in service prior to 30<sup>th</sup> May, 1998 shall retire at the end of the extended period of service but no further extension in service shall be granted.

- 2. All the administrative Ministries/Departments are requested to take necessary action in the matter.
