Department of Public Enterprises Monthly Achievements – March, 2017

1. An orientation programme for capacity building of newly appointed non-official Directors of CPSEs was organised on 17th and 18th March 2017 at Puducherry in which 26 newly appointed non-official Directors of various CPSEs participated. They were apprised about their role and responsibilities in the context of provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and other important issues pertaining to functioning of Boards.

2. Two separate Workshops on 'IND-AS' were organised on 23rd & 28th March, 2017 at Goa & Jaipur respectively in association with Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. The workshops had an overwhelming response and 88 executives of CPSES/SLPEs participated in these workshops.

3. A one- day workshop on 'Capacity building of CPSEs on procurement policy of MSME and its rules & procedure' was organised on 15th March 2017 at New Delhi for CPSEs & Administrative Ministries to sensitise them about the rules under Procurement Policy.

4. An Inter-Ministerial Committee (IMC) constituted to conduct MoU exercise has finalised MoU 2017-18 targets in respect of 22 CPSEs.

5. The information on CAPEX achievement of select CPSEs was submitted to PMO on 07.03.2017.

6. The Department has compiled the Public Enterprises Survey 2015-16 and laid the same in both the Houses of the Parliament on 21.03.2017.

7. An award has been made on 23rd March, 2017 in the matter of Arbitration between M/s Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Ltd., (MTNL) and M/s Punjab National Bank.

8. During the period 01.04.2016 to 31.03.2017, a total revenue of Rs.2,04,37,252/- has been collected from various CPSEs & other Agencies on account of Arbitration Fees.

9. DPE issued clarification on writing of Annual Performance Appraisal Reports (APARs) of top management incumbents of CPSEs on the issue of calculation of overall grades in APARs for the year 2015-16 based on MoU scores. Further, the posts of CMD and Director (Finance), Handicrafts & Handlooms Export Corporation of India Limited (HHEC) were exempted from the rule of immediate absorption.

10. Seven CCEA/Cabinet Notes were examined and seven Inter Ministerial Group (IMG) Meetings were attended during March 2017.

11. DPE has examined the CoS Note on 'guidelines on the issues relating to procedures for Exchange, Transfer, Leasing, Licensing and Sale of land, held by Government Controlled Statutory Authorities and CPSUs' and comments sent to Department of Economic Affairs on 29.03.2017.
