## Monthly achievements of DPE for the month of September, 2017

- 1. In pursuance of the recommendations of CoS made on 26.07.2017, the Sub-Committee reviewed their guidelines on time bound closure of sick/loss making CPSEs and disposal of assets in its meeting on 24.08.2017. Based on the discussions and comments received from Ministries/Departments, the said guidelines have been revised. A CoS Note alongwith the revised draft guidelines have been sent to the Cabinet Secretariat on 12.09.2017 for placing them before the CoS.
- 2. As recommended by the CoS in its meeting held on 26.7.2017 DPE has developed an online system to collect information on availability and disposal of land of CPSEs under closure/disinvestment and hosted it on http://www.mou.gov.in the portal of DPE. DPE has also written on 12.09.2017 to all administrative Ministries/Departments to instruct Chief Executives of the CPSEs which are under closure/disinvestment to fill-up the relevant data on land of their CPSEs in the online system.
- 3. DPE held meetings with select CPSEs on 05.9.2017 to review the progress of CAPEX. This was followed by meetings at PMO on the 8<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 to review CAPEX of these CPSEs.
- 4. DPE signed a MoU on 14.9.2017 with the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship and National Skill Development Corporation for imparting skill trainings to about 2000 VRS/VSS employees of CPSEs in FY 2017-18 under the CRR Scheme.
- 5. Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited has been granted Maharatna status on 07.9.2017.
- 6. A presentation was made by DPE before the CoS on 14.9.2017 regarding strengthening of the dispute resolution mechanism of PMA in DPE.
- 7. In continuation of guidelines dated 03.08.2017 and 04.08.2017 regarding pay revision of Executives of CPSEs, DPE after consultation with Department of Expenditure, has issued guidelines on 07.09.2017 regarding Location Based Compensatory Allowances and Non-Practicing Allowance (NPA) in respect of CPSEs employees.
- 8. DPE organized the following programmes/ workshops for capacity

building of officers at various levels of CPSEs:-

- (i) "Building Competencies for Personal Excellence" in association with Art of Living foundation from 28<sup>th</sup> August to 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2017 in Bangalore.
- (ii) "IND-AS" in association with Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs from 5<sup>th</sup> September to 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 in Goa.
- (iii) A workshop on "Basics of GST" in association with Institute of Cost Accountants of India in Mumbai on 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2017.
- (iv) A workshop on "Recent changes in Companies Act 2013" in association with Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs in Delhi on 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2017.
- 9. A contract been awarded to CRISIL by DPE in September 2017 for evaluation of the preparation of a report on upgradation of the Public Enterprises. The objective of the Study is to upgrade the content of PE Survey, namely, improvement of overall design/ structure, enhance its quality and readability in keeping with the current trends of similar publications of other Central Governments departments and publication of advanced countries, identifying the gaps and analytical contents on various economic and financial aspects of CPSEs. This study will be completed in three months period.
- 10. The posts of MD, Solar Energy Corporation of India and Director (Personnel), Andrew Yule & Co. Limited were exempted from the rule of immediate absorption.
