In respect of your query it is submitted that there is no parity in the scale of pay and the position / level of Government officers to that of officers / executive in the Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs). Further CPSEs are absolutely on a different footing in terms of pay structure, having different schedule (A,B,C&D) & status (Maharatna, Navratna, Miniratna). Hence, as such no equivalence can be drawn between the two. Apart from above, the role & responsibility of Class-I (Group-A) Central Government Officers are totally different than that of CPSEs executives.
