II. BPE's O.M. No. 6/55/79-BPE (GM I) dt. 13.03.1980

Reservation of posts in Public Enterprises for Ex-servicemen and dependents of those killed in action

The undersigned is directed to refer to BPE's O.M. of even number dated 22-1-1980 On the subject mentioned above circulating Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms' O.M. Notification No. 39016/10/79- 'Estt(C) dated 15-12-79 which makes available to the Ex-servicemen certain facilities, including reservations in posts and services on a permanent basis. Apoint has been raised for clarification as to whether the same percentage of reservations in public enterprises as was in force w.e.f. 1-7-74 viz, 17½%in Group III and 27½ per cent in Group IV should continue to be followed.

2. In this connection, attention is also invited to para 4 of BPE's O.M. No. BPE/GL^006/78/MAN/2(68)/76-BPE (GM-I) dated the 30th March, 1978 in which it has been stated that the Central Public Enterprises where the ceiling of 50 per cent reservations has reached, taking together reservations for SC/STs, Ex-servicemen and dependents of those killed in action and also promotions from Group D to Group C, the quota for ex-servicemen and dependents of those killed in action would be correspondingly reduced so as to enable reservations for physically

handicapped. The net percentages of reservation for ex-servicemen and dependents of those killed in action have, therefore, been reduced to 14½ per cent and 24½ per cent in Group 'C' and 'D' posts respectively in public enterprises after reserving 3 per cent of posts both in Group C and D for physically handicapped vide BPE's O.M. dated 30-3-78 mentioned above.

3. The Ministry of Industry, etc., are requested to bring this to the notice of all public sector enterprises under their administrative control for guidance and compliance.
