CORRIGENDUM


Corrigendum to the RFP for selection of agency for carrying out a study on 'Impact of activities carried out through CSR by CPSEs on the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) in last 3 years and publication of a Book highlighting the best practices on SBM' in response to the pre-bid meeting held on 29th August, 2017 in the Conference Hall of Department of Public Enterprises, CGO Complex, New Delhi and extension of last date to **15th September, 2017 at 5.00 PM.**

The following issues were discussed in the pre bid meeting held on 29.8.2017 with the prospective Bidders including those received through e-mail and the clarifications of DPE thereon are given here under:

Issues raised by the prospective Bidders		DPE's Response/ Clarifications
(i)	The Terms of Reference indicates Impact Assessment of CSR activities on Swachh Bharat Mission to be done for last 3 years. Please specify the years and make available data for 2015-16 and 2016-17.	Since the provisions on CSR in Companies Act, 2013 came into effect from 1 st April, 2014, the study on SBM will be for the years 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17. Data pertaining to allocation and expenditure on CSR by CPSEs for the year 2016-17 has not been compiled yet. However, the data for 2015-16 is available and is attached. Data for 2014-15 already given in RFP.
(ii)	Whether study to cover SBM only or other areas like sports/ women empowerment etc.?	The study will cover SBM only as per Terms of Reference given in Section 7 of the RFP. Besides, submission of the study report, the selected bidder will also submit manuscript of the book to be published highlighting the best practices on SBM.
(iii)	Discussions shall be in the form of a workshop at New Delhi and formal interaction with CPSEs. Who will organize the workshop and whether the cost is to be included in the Bid Proposal?	DPE will organize the workshop in cooperation with the selected bidder for deliberations with various stakeholders and experts before submission of final report. Therefore, the cost of organizing the workshop need not be part of the Bid proposal
(iv)	RFP is silent on field coverage and sample. This needs to be clarified?	DPE does not want to restrict the study by giving a fixed sample size. The study has to be done covering all the 134 CSR eligible CPSEs by obtaining preliminary data from them and analyzing the secondary data for selecting CPSEs for the proposed study including field visits and interactions with beneficiaries.
(v)	The study requires publication of a book, who will do it and how many pages and how many copies to be printed?	After completion of the study, the manuscript of the proposed book to be printed has to be furnished by the selected agency to DPE. DPE will get it

		printed at its own cost. Therefore, the cost of printing of the book on SBM need not be included in the financial bid.
(vi)	Please clarify how many private sector companies and how many overseas agencies are to be included within the scope of the study	For value addition of the study report, a few best practices adopted by private sector companies and overseas companies may be included based on scrutiny of available literature, reports and other materials in public domain. No survey is expected of such companies but their authenticity needs to be ensured.
(vii)	Is this a 4 month project to finish the entire work including finalizing and publishing the book	Yes, except that the selected agency will provide the manuscript of the proposed book within the prescribed period of 4 months of the study. DPE will get this book printed at its own cost
(viii)	There are 134 companies in your list of CPSEs. The total time for completion of the work as stated in your ToR is 4 months. We wish to know whether you will distribute the work among several consultancy agencies or you intend to give the contract to one agency.	The entire study will be given to one agency. Subcontracting of the work by the selected agency will not be allowed.
(ix)	Whether the bidder needs to quote one lump sum cost of the entire project or DPE wants activity wise cost break up?	As the method of selection will be on the basis of lowest financial bid (L1) of the technically qualified bidders, the lump sum cost of the entire project including all taxes quoted by the bidder will be the sole criteria for final selection after opening of the financial bid. However, giving activity-wise cost break up and indicating the lump sum amount including taxes will be preferable.
(x)	As the bidders are required to submit the bid proposal either in person or by post, they may be given at least 10 days' time after the clarifications to the points raised during the pre-bid meeting are uploaded in the public domain	In view of the clarifications now being given by DPE to the points raised by several bidders and to enable them to formulate their proposal and submit to DPE in time, the last date is extended to 15th September, 2017 at 5.00 PM.
