Subject: - Settlement of commercial disputes between Central Public-sector Enterprises (CPSEs) inter se CPSE(s) and Government Departments/Organization(s) - Administrative Mechanism for Resolution of CPSEs Disputes (AMRCD).

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM No. 05/0003/2019-FTS-10937 dated 14.12.2022 on the subject cited above and to state that certain Government Department(s)/ Organization(s) / CPSEs have sought clarification regarding the amicable settlements of disputes under AMRCD.

- 2. In this regard, it is clarified that where both parties have settled a case amicably, the concerned Ministry/Department shall upload a signed copy of the settlement, duly endorsed by both parties, on the AMRCD portal as the final decision. Upon such uploading, the case will automatically stand removed from the list of pending cases before the Committee of Secretaries (CoS) and will be reflected under the "Decided Cases" category.
- 3. It is further clarified that there is no provision in the AMRCD portal to drop or delete a case after issuance of the CoS notification.
- 4. All Administrative Ministries/Departments and State Governments concerned with CPSEs/PSUs /Government Organizations are requested to bring these guidelines to the notice of all the entities under their administrative control for strict compliance.
- 5. This issue with the approval of Secretary, Department of Public Enterprises.
