Subject: Writ petitions by CPSEs against the service matter disputes referred to the Industrial Tribunals – Reference received from Chief Labour Commission (CLC) - regarding.

The undersigned is directed to refer to above mentioned subject and to say that Chief Labour Commissioner (CLC), Ministry of Labour and Employment (L&Ê) vide letter dated 17.04.2018 (copy enclosed) has brought to the notice of this Department that a few CPSEs have been filing Writ petitions in various High Courts in a routine manner against the disputes referred to Industrial Tribunals for adjudication. In one such matter, the Hon'ble Court has expressed its concern on unnecessary litigation resorted to by CPSEs.

- 2. In this regard, it is mentioned that it is the consistent position of the Government to reduce the litigation between government agencies. The CLC, M/o L&E has also observed that CPSEs instead of filing Writ petitions in a routine manner may challenge only those cases in which the CPSE policy or larger legal issues are involved.
- All administrative Ministries / Departments are requested to bring the observations of CLC to the notice of CPSEs under their administrative control for necessary action.
