Monthly Achievement of DPE for the Cabinet for the month of
February, 2025

1. Capital Expenditure in CPSEs and other Government organizations: -

The information of CAPEX achievement for select CPSEs (having annual CAPEX estimates of ₹100 crore or more) and other Government organizations [viz. Railway Board, National Highway Authority of India, Delhi Metro Rail Corporation and Damodar Valley Corporation] for the year 2024-25 till the end of February, 2025 was submitted to PMO on 05.03.2025. As on 28th February, 2025, these entities have achieved CAPEX of ₹7.39 lakh crore, which is 93.95%, of the revised estimates of ₹7.87 lakh crore for the financial year 2024-25.

2. MoU of CPSEs: -

Performance evaluation of 91 CPSEs through MoUs for the year 2023-24 has been completed.

3. Governance of CPSEs:

- a. The Department of Public Enterprises (DPE) has sent its consent on the proposal of:-
 - i. Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities for the revival of 80 posts on below board level posts in ALIMCO on 21st February, 2025.
 - ii. Ministry of Heavy Industries for the exemption of 04 posts on below board level posts in Cement Corporation of India Limited (CCIL) from the rule of immediate absorption on 21st February, 2025.
- b. DPE has sent its comments on exemption to NLC India Limited (NLCIL) from the extant guidelines for delegation of power to Navratna CPSEs for making investment beyond the prescribed limited in NLC India Renewables Limited (NIRL), a wholly owned subsidiary and its other JVs/ subsidiaries to set up 10.11 GW renewable energy (RE) capacity by 2030 and 32 GW RE capacity by 2047 on 24th February, 2025.
- c. DPE vide its O.M. dated 11.02.2025 has issued guidelines regarding writing of APAR of Top management incumbents of CPSEs for the year FR 2023-24 wherein the process of creating VPN accounts for concerned CPSE executives to access CPSE-SPARROW system is simplified.

4. Inter-Ministerial Meetings and CCEA/Cabinet Notes:

- a. An IMC meeting was held during the month of February, 2025 to review the progress of closure of CPSEs approved by GoI under M/o Heavy Industries.

- b. An meeting was held on 13th February, 2025 to discuss the revival package including one time assistance of Rs. 215.44 crore for BIBCOLD, a CPSE under D/o Biotechnology.
- c. DPE furnished comments on the draft Cabinet Note circulated by the Department of Legal Affairs for introduction of the Commercial Courts (Amendment) Bill, 2025.

5. Capacity Building:

79 employees of DPE (including YPs/ YAs) have completed 2,592 courses on I-GOT portal till 28th February, 2025.

6. Asset Monetization: -

A meeting of core Group of Secretaries on Asset Monetization (CGAM) was held on 06.02.2025 and a meeting of Committee of Secretary (CoS) was held on 07.02.2025 for reviewing the monetization of Land & building assets of BSNL/ MTNL under DoT.

7. Status of AMRCD cases:

As per updated status, 195 cases were reported/registered on the portal. 50 cases were rejected at the level of Financial Advisors. 50 cases have been settled and 72 cases are with the Committee of Secretaries for decisions. Remaining 23 cases are pending with Financial Advisors concerned for their scrutiny and approval.
