Monthly Summary of Department of Public Enterprises (DPE) for the month of August, 2025

1. Capital Expenditure in CPSEs and other Government organizations: -

The information of CAPEX achievement for select CPSEs (having annual CAPEX estimates of Rs. 100 crore or more) and other Government organizations (viz Railway Board, National Highway Authority of India, Delhi Metro Rail Corporation and Damodar Valley Corporation) for the year 2025-26 till the end of August, 2025 was compiled. During April- August 2025, these entities have achieved CAPEX of Rs. 2.72 lakh crore, which is 34.70% of the annual budget estimates of Rs.7.85 lakh crore for the financial year 2025-26,

2. Governance of CPSEs: -

- (i) DPE sent its consent on the proposal of Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance for the exemption of 7 posts on below board level posts in Security Printing and Minting Corporation of India Limited (SPMCIL) from the rule of immediate absorption on 31st July, 2025.
- (ii) DPE sent its comments on Ministry of New & Renewable energy to Exercise of the enhanced power delegated to SECI in respect of Navratna Status on 08th August, 2025.
- (iii) The meeting of Apex Committee was held on 13th August, 2025 on the comprehensive review of Maharatna & Navratna CPSEs and schedule A/B/C/D categorization guidelines.

3. MoU- CPSEs' performance evaluation: -

For year 2024-25: Evaluation of 90 MoU-signing CPSE's performance will commence in October, 2025, after availability of audited accounts.

For year 2025-26: In the process of finalization of the MoUs for year 2025-26, the MoU targets for 86 CPSEs were finalized. Out of which, 83 MoUs have been signed.

4. Inter-Ministerial Meetings and CCEA/Cabinet Notes: -

- (i) 01 IMC meeting was attended during the month of August, 2025.
- (ii) 01 IMG meeting was attended during the month of August, 2025.

5. Capacity Building: -

- (i) DPE organized two workshops on Industry 4.0 for CPSEs in South and West India on 22nd August, 2025 in Mumbai which were attended by around 75 participants comprising of senior executives of CPSEs (CMDs and Directors). The workshops focused on role of emerging Industry 4.0 technologies in bringing transformative productivity, efficiency and innovation in the public sector. Secretary, DPE and experts explained about technologies like AI, Digital Twin, 3D Printing, etc., and their role in transforming the industries and way forward for CPSEs.
- (ii) 83 employees of DPE (including YPs/YAs) have completed 3,171 courses on I-GOT portal till August, 2025.
- (iii) As part of capacity building of employees of DPE, 4 officials of DPE undertook exposure visit to NHPC Limited with the working of the CPSEs.

6. Training Programme/Workshops: -

- (i) The details of 4 training programs/workshops organized by DPE for the officers of CPSEs/SLPEs during the month of August, 2025.

7. Procurement of MSEs:-

Procurement by CPSEs from the MSEs is around Rs. 29,824 crores out of total procurement of Rs. 70,402 crore till now. Procurement from SC/ST owned MSEs and Women owned MSEs have been reached to Rs.1,177 crore and Rs. 2,008 crore respectively.

8. Status of AMRCD cases: -

Based on the Report obtained from AMRCD dashboard as on 01.09.2025, 218 cases have been reported on the portal. 53. cases were rejected at the level of Financial Advisors. 55 cases are settled and 93 cases are with the Committee of Secretaries for decisions. Remaining 17 cases are pending with Financial Advisors concerned for their scrutiny and approval.
