Monthly Summary of DPE for the month of July, 2025

1.. Governance of CPSEs: -

- i. Department of Public Enterprises (DPE) sent its consent on the proposal of Ministry of Railways for the exemption of 13 posts on below board level posts in Braithwaite & Company Limited (BCL) from the rule of immediate absorption on 16th July, 2025.
- ii. DPE vide OMs dated 09.07.2025 has revised Dearness Allowance for the CPSEs following 2017, 2007, 1997, 1992 & 1987 IDA pay scales.
- iii. DPE vide OMs dated 22.07.2025 has also issued Consolidated & revised guidelines on Vigilance Policy or CPSEs.

2. MoU- CPSEs' performance evaluation:

For year 2024-25: Evaluation of 90 MoU-signing CPSE's performance will commence in October, 2025, after availability of audited accounts.

For year 2025-26: In the process of finalization of the MoUs for year 2025-26, the MoU targets for 87 CPSEs (out of 87) have been finalized.

3. Inter-Ministerial Meetings and CCEA/Cabinet Notes: -

- (i) 02 CMCDC meetings were attended during the month of July, 2025.
- (ii) 03 IMG meetings were attended during the month of July, 2025.
- (iii) 02 Mid-year Review meetings were attended during the month of July, 2025.

4. Capacity Building: -

- (i) DPE, with the support of SJVN Limited, organized residential orientation programme for capacity building of Functional Directors (FDs) of CPSEs on 10th and 11th July, 2025 at Dharamshala. 22 Functional Directors(FD)s of various CPSEs participated in the programme in which sessions relating to Perspectives on Board Effectiveness & role of Functional Directors, Strategic Management for Board level functionaries, Transformative Board Leadership, Improving Effectiveness of Audit function in CPSEs and Important DPE guidelines, were taken by eminent Faculty.
- (ii) 89 employees of DPE (including YPs/ YAs) have completed 3416 courses on I-GoT portal till July, 2025.
- (iii) As part of capacity building of employees of DPE, 3 officials of DPE undertook exposure visit to NHPC Limited and 5 DPE officials visited GRSE Limited to familiarize themselves with the working of the CPSEs.

5. Corporate Social Responsibility

DPE and UNICEF jointly organized the 5th regional workshop on CSR with focus on Aspirational Districts of Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Kerala and Maharashtra on 31st July, 2025 at Hyderabad. The workshop elicited good response from all stakeholders with more than 100 participants from Aspirational Districts (ADs) of above states, CSR Nodal officers of CPSEs, officers from State Governments, NITI Aayog, Implementing agencies, DPE and UNICEF.

6. Training Programme/Workshops

(i) DPE organized two workshops on Industry 4.0 for CPSEs on 18th July, 2025 in New Delhi which were attended by more than 100 participants comprising of senior executives of CPSEs (CMDs and Directors) and senior officers from concerned administrative Ministries/Departments. The workshops focused on role of emerging Industry 4.0 technologies in bringing transformative productivity, efficiency and innovation on the public sector. Secretary (DPE) and experts explained about technologies like AI, Digital Twin, 3D Printing, etc, and their role in transforming the industries and way forward for CPSEs.

(ii) 5 training programs/workshops organized by DPE for officers of CPSEs/SLPEs during the month of July, 2025.

7. Mission Recruitment

3,766 new appointees of CPSEs were covered in 19th tranche of Rozgar Mela organized by DoPT on 12th July, 2025. 62,166 new appointees of CPSEs have been covered in 16 tranches of Rozgar Mela organized by DoPT so far.

8. Status of AMRCD cases: -

Based on the Report obtained from AMRCD dashboard as on 31.07.2025, 217 cases have been reported on the portal. 51 cases were rejected at the level of Financial Advisors. 51 cases have been settled and 94 cases are with the Committee of Secretaries for decisions. Remaining 21 cases are pending with Financial Advisors concerned for their scrutiny and approval.
