

## **Monthly achievements of DPE for the month of April, 2022**

### **1. CAPEX targets:**

The information relating to annual CAPEX targets of Rs. 6.58 lakh crores (budget estimates) and its achievement in respect of select CPSEs (having annual CAPEX target of Rs. 100 crores & above) and other government organizations up to the month of April, 2022 was submitted to PMO on 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2022. Against an estimated expenditure of Rs. 6.58 lakh crores (approx.), achievement is Rs. 0.24 lakh crores (approx.) or about 03.62%

### **2. Pay Revision and Wage Notification:**

i) DPE vide OM dated 08.04.2022 and 12.04.2022 issued DA orders w.e.f 01.04.2022 for 2017, 2007, 1997, 1992 & 1987 IDA pay scales.

ii) DPE vide OMs dated 11.04.2022 and 28.04.2022 issued guidelines on revision of DA for employees of CPSEs following CDA pay scales as per 7<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> CPC recommendations w.e.f. 01.01.2022.

### **3. New Public Sector Enterprises (PSE) Policy**

DPE processed the proposal for initial categorizations of SPV- Karamayogi Bharat as a Schedule "A" CPSE and forwarded the same to Public Selection Board for their consideration & recommendation.

### **4. Inter-Ministerial Meetings and Special Campaign:**

i) DPE furnished its comments on the following notes circulated for inter-ministerial consultations:

a) Proposal of Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship for continuation/ extension of National Apprentice Promotion Scheme (NAPS) beyond FY 2021-22.

b) Proposal of Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises regarding draft policy for MSMEs in India.

### **5. Training programmes/workshops:**

i) DPE participated in the interaction meeting organized by Government e-marketplace (GeM) with top 50 procuring CPSEs on functioning of GeM portal.

ii) DPE and Capacity Building Commission (CBC) in collaboration with Department of Personnel & Training (DoPT) and Public Enterprises Selection Board (PESB) organized one-day workshop on 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 on ‘Succession Planning and Leadership Development in Maharatna CPSEs’ at New Delhi. The meeting was attended by CMDs, Director (HR) and ED (HR)/ GM (HR) of Maharatna CPSEs. Secretary (DoPT), Secretary (DPE), Chairman (PESB) and Chairman (CBC) addressed the participants along with two eminent external speakers, namely, Ms. Anuradha Razdan from Hindustan Unilever and Shri Yogi Sriram from L & T. The participating CPSEs made presentations on processes and good practices adopted by them followed by group exercises on the subject.

iii) DPE organized a virtual meeting of SOE track with select CPSEs on 11<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 as part of stakeholders’ discussions with respect to proposed chapter on SOEs in India-UK FTA.

iv) Meeting of Oversight Committee was held on 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 to discuss issues related to implementation of RDC scheme for the year 2022-23.

Public Enterprises Survey 2020-21 report was laid in the Parliament (Rajya Sabha) on 07.04.2022.
