Was last posted as Secretary in the Government of India, before retirement on 31st August 2013. Have held various positions in key economic Ministries under both the State and Central Government in India. Before joining as Secretary, Ministry of Steel, was Secretary, Department of Public Enterprises, which is the nodal Department of Government of India for more than 250 state owned enterprises (PSUs) and lays down policy guidelines on various issues such as CSR, Corporate Governance, Human Resource Management and Sustainable Development. He earlier was posted as Special Secretary in the Ministry of Home Affairs, heading, *inter alia*, the Human Rights Division. Last posting before retirement was Secretary in the Ministry of Steel, which is responsible for facilitating the growth of iron and steel industry and for the development of essential inputs for the industry such as iron-ore, limestone and dolomite. Ministry of Steel is concerned with policy formulation regarding various aspects of the steel industry, apart from being the administrative ministry for PSUs such as SAIL, NMDC and RINL. Apart from overseeing the performance of the PSUs under its administrative jurisdiction, it is responsible for identification of infrastructural and other issues being faced by the industry and their resolution. It provides a platform for interaction at the apex level of producers and consumers of steel across the country to harmonize views and policy.

Earlier, as Additional Secretary and Financial Adviser also in the Govt. of India, was posted in the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion, which is, *inter alia*, responsible for facilitation of technology and investment flow and promotion of industrial development in the liberalized environment.

Also worked as Joint Secretary in the Department of Heavy Industry, which deals with a large number of PSUs and is the administrative ministry for the automobile and electric engineering sectors. Was Director/Joint Secretary, Department of Economic Affairs (Banking Division) in the Government of India earlier, following which had worked, as Finance Secretary in the Government of Madhya Pradesh.

Overall, while specializing in Finance & Industry sectors in his career, have remained interested in People, Land Management and Eco-system preservation. Hobbies include bird-watching and trekking, as am a keen lover of nature.

Criteria for selection/appointment of non-official Directors on the Boards of CPSEs as laid down by the Government

(A) **Criteria of Experience**

- (i) Retired Government officials with a minimum of 10 years experience at Joint Secretary level or above.
- (ii) Persons who have retired as CMD/CEOs of CPSEs and Functional Directors of the Schedule 'A' CPSEs. The ex-Chief Executives and ex-Functional Directors of the CPSEs will not be considered for appointment as non-official Director on the Board of the CPSE from which they retire. Serving Chief Executives/Directors of CPSEs will not be eligible to be considered for appointment as non-official Directors on the Boards of any CPSEs.
- (iii) Academicians/Directors of Institutes/Heads of Department and Professors having more than 10 years teaching or research experience in the relevant domain e.g. management, finance, marketing, technology, human resources, or law.
- (iv) Professionals of repute having more than 15 years of relevant domain experience in fields relevant to the company's area of operation.
- (v) Former CEOs of private companies if the company is (a) listed on the Stock Exchanges or (b) unlisted but profit making and having an annual turnover of at least Rs.250 crore.
- (vi) Persons of eminence with proven track record from Industry, Business or Agriculture or Management.

(B) **Criteria of Educational Qualification**

Minimum graduate degree from a recognized university.

(C) **Criteria of Age**

The age band should be between 45-65 years (minimum/maximum limit)

This could, however, be relaxed for eminent professionals, for reasons to be recorded, being limited to 70 years.
