

Monthly achievements of DPE for the month of April, 2020

1. A meeting was held through VC mode on 22nd April, 2020 with chief Executives of select CPSEs operating in important sectors such as Oil & Gas, Coal, Steel, Power, Mining, Defence, etc. to discuss the situation arising from COVID-19 outbreak, its impact on the functioning of CPSEs and possible remedial strategies. The suggestions made by the CPSEs during the meeting have been forwarded to the concerned Ministries for their appropriate action.
2. A meeting was held on 28th April, 2020 through VC mode with select CPSEs to discuss the measures required to enhance the procurement by CPSEs from GeM Portal. The meeting was Co-Chaired by Secretary, DPE and CEO, GeM. In the meeting various issues relating to on-boarding of CPSEs and their vendors on GeM portal were discussed so that the level of procurement by CPSEs from GeM can be enhanced.
3. Based on the issues brought out by administrative Ministries/Departments, DPE has submitted CoS Note to the Cabinet Secretariat on 24.04.2020 which inter alia suggests revised guidelines on disposal of land and simplified procedure for striking of the name of the company from the Register of Companies so as to expedite the process of closure of CPSEs already decided by competent authority for closure.
4. The recommendation made by the Department – related Parliamentary Standing Committee on Industry for filling up vacancies of critical posts in CPSEs through regular incumbents instead of contractual basis was circulated to all administrative Ministries/Departments and CPSEs for compliance.
5. The information for CAPEX of selected CPSEs and other Organisations for the month of March, 2020 has been submitted to PMO on 21st April, 2020.
6. Quarterly achievement of finance & production parameters of some CPSEs for the last five years has been collected.
7. DPE vide OMs dated 03.04.2020 has issued separate IDA orders for the employees of CPSEs w.e.f. 01.04.2020 drawing 2017, 2007,1997,1992 & 1987 IDA pay scales respectively.
8. Further, DPE vide OM dated 28.04.2020 has extended the Department of Expenditure (DOE)'s OM dated 23.04.2020 on freezing of Dearness Allowance / Dearness Relief in respect of CDA employees of CPSEs.
