

Monthly achievements of DPE for the month of March, 2020

1. A conference was organized by DPE on 3rd March, 2020 at New Delhi on the best practices being implemented in School Education, Health Care and Nutrition sectors for transformation of Aspirational Districts through CSR initiatives of CPSEs. The conference was attended by 359 participants which included CEO, NITI Aayog, senior executives from CPSEs, DM/ DCs of select Aspirational districts, Central Prabhari Officers, Project Ministries/ Departments. Shri Prakash Javadekar, Hon'ble Minister (HI&PE), Chief Guest of the Conference, addressed the participants during Valedictory session.
2. DPE made a presentation before the Parliamentary Committee for Empowerment of Women on the subject of 'Corporate Social Responsibility towards Women' on 19th March, 2020 at Parliament House Annexe, New Delhi.
3. A proposal of Ministry of Mines for reconstitution of Board of Directors of Hindustan Cooper Limited (HCL) was considered in consultation with Public Enterprises Selection Board and the abolition of post of Director (Personnel) on the Board of HCL, proposed therein, was agreed to by DPE.
4. The proposal of Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas for (i) initial categorization of Bharat Gas Resources Limited (BGRL), a wholly owned subsidiary of Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited, as a Schedule 'B' CPSE and (ii) creation of 3 Board level posts, i.e., Managing Director, Director (Marketing & Business Development) and Director (Operations & Projects) on the Board of BGRL was considered in consultation with Public Enterprises Selection Board and was agreed to DPE.
5. DPE issued the following instructions/ guidelines to Ministries/ CPSEs on COVID-19 relating issues:
 - a) Instructions issued on 11th March, 2020 to all CPSEs to extend their medical facilities for the requirement of the concerned State Govts after catering to their own requirements, to fight the COVID 19 outbreak.
 - b) Extension of guidelines dated 17th March, 2020 of DOPT to CPSEs regarding preventive steps to be taken to contain the spread of COVID 19.
 - c) Instructions to take preventive measures to contain the spread of COVID 19 vide OM dated 22nd March, 2020.
 - d) Instructions to CPSEs on 23rd March, 2020 to comply with the directions of Ministry of Labour regarding non-deduction of wages of the contractual staff/ casual workers and other welfare measures.
 - e) Instructions to ensure timely payment to the employees and workers employed in CPSEs as per the orders issued by MHA on 29th March, 2020.
6. A clarification was issued on 27th March, 2020 to all Ministries/ Departments and CPSEs to strictly follow the prescribed procedure under Administrative Mechanism for Resolution of CPSEs Dispute (AMRCD) so that CPSEs or government entities which are parties to a commercial dispute, resolve the same by approaching their administrative Ministries/ Departments.
7. A presentation on MoU Evaluation 2018-19 of CPSEs was made to High Powered Committee chaired by Cabinet Secretary on 4th March, 2020 and MoU Score & Rating of 114 CPSEs for the year 2018-19 was issued on 14th March, 2020.
8. The information on CAPEX of select CPSEs and other organizations for the month of February, 2020 was submitted to PMO on 6th March, 2020.
