Monthly achievements of DPE for the month of December, 2020

1. A review meeting on CAPEX by CPSEs in North Eastern region was held in respect of NRL & Oil India Ltd. under the Chairmanship of Secretary, DPE on 18th December, 2020 in Guwahati, Assam.
2. The information for CAPEX of selected CPSEs and other Organizations for the month of November, 2020 was submitted to PMO on 4th December, 2020.
3. DPE circulated a Draft Cabinet Note (DCN) on 17th July, 2020 on revised guidelines of DPE on “Time bound closure of sick/loss making CPSEs and disposal of movable and immovable assets” for inter-ministerial consultation prepared on the basis of the recommendations of CoS on 22nd May, 2020. Thereafter, a meeting was held on 31.08.2020 under the chairmanship of Principal Advisor to PMO. Based on the comments/suggestions and further deliberations held, the DCN and the proposed guidelines have been modified and a revised DCN has been circulated on 21.10.2020 for inter-ministerial consultation. After compilation of the comments received from various Ministries/ Departments, a final Note has been submitted for the approval of the competent authority.
4. DPE circulated Draft MoU guidelines for FY 2021-22 with new framework for MoU system for the CPSEs to members of the Group & HPC.
5. Nine draft Cabinet/CCEA/EFC Notes of other Ministries/ Departments received for comments have been examined by DPE and issued comments thereon.
6. Seventeen IMG/CGD/EFC/EC meetings have been attended during the month of December, 2020.
7. DPE has taken up with select CPSEs requesting them to procure cold chain equipment through their CSR funds as per state-wise requirements indicated by the Department of Health & Family Welfare and supply the same to the concerned State Government Authorities. The progress of procurement by the CPSEs was regularly reviewed to facilitate timely supply of required cold chain equipment.
8. The instructions for extending the time-lines for writing Annual Performance Appraisal Reports of top management incumbents of CPSEs for the year 2019-20, as a one-time measure, were issued.
9. DPE considered the proposal of Ministry of Textiles for bifurcating the post of CMD, Jute Corporation of India into part-time Chairman, JCI and

Managing Director, JCI separately, in consultation with Public Enterprises Selection Board and agreed to the same.

10. DPE extended the relaxation notified by the Government in respect of officers of AIS for waiving the condition of submission of summary of Medical Report to APARs of top management incumbents of CPSEs for the year 2019-20 as a one-time measure keeping in view of the situation arising out of the spread of COVID-19.
11. As advised by the High Level Committee of Department of Economic Affairs, all administrative Ministries have been requested to direct CPSEs under their administrative jurisdiction to examine the matter of locating their data/information processing centres in GIFT IFSC.
