Monthly achievements in respect of DPE for the month of November,
2022

1. CAPEX targets:

The information relating to annual CAPEX targets of ₹6.62 lakh crores (budget estimates) and its achievement in respect of select CPSEs (having annual CAPEX target of ₹100 crores & above) and other government organizations up to the month of November, 2022 was submitted to PMO on 5th December, 2022. Against an estimated expenditure of ₹6.62 lakh crores (approx.), achievement is ₹3.97 lakh crores (approx.) i.e. about 59.94% as on 30.11.2022.

2. Governance of CPSEs:

- i. DPE agreed to exempt 82 technical posts of Food & Nutrition Board under M/o Women & Child Development from the rule of immediate absorption for a period of 3 years so as to facilitate their deployment to FCI.
- ii. Two posts of ED (E-9 level) [namely, ED (HR) and ED (Fin)] and two posts of GM (E-8 level) [namely, GM(HR) and GM(M&C)] in Hindustan Copper Ltd were exempted from the rule of immediate absorption.
- iii. The proposal of M/o Petroleum and Natural Gas regarding merger of post of Director (Offshore) and Director (Onshore), and creation of post of Director (Strategy & Corporate Affairs) in ONGC Ltd was considered in consultation with Public Enterprises Selection Board (PESB) and agreed to.
- iv. The proposal of re-categorization of National Film Development Corporation from Schedule 'C' to 'B' was considered in DPE and forwarded to PESB.

3. Inter-Ministerial Meetings and CCEA/ Cabinet Notes:

- i. Four CGD/IMG/CMCDC meetings were held during the month.
- ii. DPE furnished its comments on the following notes circulated for inter-ministerial consultations:
 - a. Draft Cabinet Note circulated by the M/o Cooperation for the Cabinet on 'strengthening cooperative movement in the country and deepening its reach up to the grassroots';
 - b. Draft National Strategic Framework circulated by NITI Aayog for making India as Global Hub of Assistive Technologies;
 - c. EFC Memo circulated by the D/o Expenditure on revised Overseas Promotion and Publicity Scheme for the Period of 2022-23 to 2024-25;
 - d. Three draft Notes for the Cabinet circulated by the M/o Cooperation on setting up of National level Multi-State Seed Cooperative Society, National level Multi-State Cooperative Society for Organic Products and National Cooperative Export Society, under Multi State Cooperative Societies Act, 2002;
 - e. Draft Cabinet Note circulated by the D/o Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade for introduction of the Ease of Doing Business and Ease of Living (Amendment Provisions) Bill, 2022.

- iii. DPE participated in 3rd round of India-EU FTA and Intersessional on India-UK FTA negotiations in respect of chapter on SoEs.
- iv. Suggestions in respect of Direct and Indirect taxes, reducing compliances, providing tax certainty and reducing litigations were obtained from various CPSEs and submitted to D/o Revenue.

4. Events and Activities implemented:

- i. The instructions of M/o Culture regarding '*Har Ghar Dhyan*' campaign under the aegis of *Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav* were circulated to all CPSEs for information and further necessary action.
- ii. Instructions of Cabinet Secretary and M/o External Affairs for widespread use and mainstreaming of the G20 Logo and Theme during India's Presidency were circulated to all CPSEs for information and further necessary action.

5. Training programmes/workshops:

DPE conducted 8 training programmes and 5 workshops during the month which were attended by 472 executives of CPSEs/SLPEs.

6. Matters relating to procurement through GeM and MSMEs:

All CPSEs were requested to ensure uploading of information on MSME SAMBANDH and MSME SAMADHAAN portal regularly. The CPSEs have informed that they are regularly uploading the information on the portals. As per data available on MSME Sambandh Portal, CPSEs have procured 35.76% from MSEs during the year 2022-23 as against the mandated 25%.

7. Mission Recruitment:

In order to facilitate implementation of '*Mission Recruitment*' in CPSEs, review meeting was held with Nodal officers of CPSEs on 4th November, 2022. As per information furnished by the Department of Personnel & Training the progress of PSUs was 14,911 and 13,584 for the month of October, 2022 and November, 2022 respectively.
