Monthly achievements of DPE for the month of February, 2022

1. CAPEX targets:

The information relating to annual CAPEX targets of Rs.5.95 lakh crores and its achievement in respect of select CPSEs & other government organisations up to the month of February, 2022 was submitted to PMO on 4th March, 2022. Against an estimated annual expenditure of Rs.5.95 lakh crores (approx.), achievement is Rs. 4.71 lakh crores (approx) or about 79.28%.

2. Pay Revision and Wage Notification:

DPE has issued guidelines for keeping double/ additional transport allowance out of the 50%/35% ceiling for Divyangjan on 21.02.2022

3. Instructions of various Ministries to all CPSEs:

i) In line with instructions of Department of Expenditure (DoE) including Insurance Surety Bonds as Security Instrument for accepting Bid Security and Performance Security, all CPSEs were requested to consider using Insurance Surety Bonds for Bid and Performance Security in addition to the existing available instruments.

ii) As requested by Ministry of Information & Broadcasting, all CPSEs were advised to ensure that the copies of the fortnightly magazine 'New India Samachar' published by Bureau of Outreach and Communication are kept in all lounges/ waiting rooms/holding areas of CPSEs in order to extend the reach and spread of this publication.

4. Review of Closure of CPSEs:

The status of closure of 23 CPSEs/ units of CPSEs was reviewed with the administrative ministries on 3rd and 8th February 2022

5. New Public Sector Enterprises (PSE) Policy:

A meeting of Committee of Group of Officers (CGO) constituted to identify the CPSEs for closure or privatization in the non-strategic sectors as outlined in the New Public Sector Enterprises (PSE) Policy was held on 11.02.2022 under the chairmanship of Chief Executive Officer, NITI Aayog to consider the CPSEs under the administrative control of Ministry of Chemicals & Fertilizers.

6. Inter-Ministerial Meetings and Special Campaign:

DPE participated in five IMG/CGD/CMCDC meetings held during the month.

7. Training programmes/workshops:

DPE organized six training programmes & one workshop during the month through online/residential mode which were attended by 277 executives of CPSEs/ SLPEs
