	<p>In India UPSC hire IAS/IPS/IFS/IRS, in which upper age limit is 32 years for General category. But in mostly PSUs (IOCL,EIL,NTPC ETC.) upper age limit is limited to 25 years for executive level entry/GET for general candidate.</p> <p>Kindly give the detail information, why there is upper age limit for the above said post (executive level entry/GET) in mostly PSUs (IOCL,EIL,NTPC ETC.) is 25 years for general candidate. why it is not 30 or 32 years.</p>	<p>The information sought in your RTI is in form of query, which do not form 'Information' within the provisions of RTI Act 2005. It is important to note that only such information can be supplied under the Act that is available and existing and is held by the public authority or is held under the control of the public authority. The Public Information Officer is not supposed to create information that is not a part of the record of the public authority. The Public Information Officer is also not required to furnish information which require drawing of inference and/or making of assumptions; or to interpret information; or to solve the problems raised by the applicant.</p> <p>However, it is mentioned that Department of Public Enterprises (DPE) is Nodal Department for Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs). CPSEs are non-homogeneous group of companies working under different sectors and conditions / requirement of jobs are commercial in nature as such recruitments in CPSEs to all posts below Board level are done by the Management of respective CPSEs as per their H.R. Policy / recruitment rules. The necessary qualification, experience, age and other eligibility criterion for all posts below Board level is decided accordingly by the respective CPSEs themselves. Department of Public Enterprises has not issued any guideline in this regard.</p>
